Minneapolis, Jan. 5.—May wheat closed 1 1/4 higher. July wheat 1/4 higher. Chicago May wheat 13-14 higher.

There was another big upward swing in the wheat market today but all of the advance was not maintained and prices at the close are down 13-14 cents from the high mark for May while the July is down 3-4 @ 7-c from the top figures. New high marks were registered and May wheat sold up to \$1.25 7-8 @ \$1.26.

Liverpool cables were strong and from 1 to 2d higher than yesterday. Minneapolis stocks of wheat increased 1,000,000 bushels for the past week.
