The Primary Ballots

On this page are reproduced samples of the official ballots which will be used in the primary election on June 28. On the left will be found the REPUBLICAN BALLOT, which will be given to all REPUBLICAN voters. Each voter is required to mark an "X" after the name of each candidate for whom he wishes to vote. On this sample ballot an "X" has been marked after the names of all the League STATE CANDIDATES. Preserve this sample and take it with you to the polls, so that you may be sure to VOTE FOR ALL THE LEAGUE'S CANDIDATES. Mark an "X" on the official ballot opposite the name of every Candidate for whom an "X" is marked in this sample ballot.

THE SMALL BALLOT reproduced above is the JUDICIARY BALLOT. This will be handed to all VOTERS, without regard to party. The LEAGUE'S CANDIDATES FOR THE SUPREME COURT are Luther E. Birdzell, R. H. Grace and J. E. Robinson. Their names are marked with an "X". Mark your ballot in the primaries in this way so as to insure the election of a supreme court which will GIVE JUSTICE TO THE POOR MAN AND INTERPRET THE LAWS FAIRLY.

League Legislative Candidates

At the bottom of the official ballot in the primaries will be found the names of candidates for the state senate and house of representatives. These names are not printed here because they are different in each different legislative district. On page 22 of this issue of the Leader will be found THE COMPLETE LIST OF LEGISLATIVE CANDIDATES INDORSED BY THE LEAGUE. Find the names of the men indorsed in YOUR DISTRICT from this list and mark an "X" after the name of EACH CANDIDATE so indorsed.

For State Treasurer

The League candidate for State Treasurer is P. M. CASEY and his name will appear on the Democratic ballot. As MR. CASEY has no opposition in the primaries he will be nominated. So the space for State Treasurer candidates is left blank, and voters in the Republican primaries need not vote for any candidate for this office.

Candidates for Other Offices

The League has not indorsed any candidates for UNITED STATES SENATOR or for REPRESENTATIVES IN CONGRESS. Consequently the spaces opposite these offices have been left blank.

THE LEAGUE HAS INDORSED for Superintendent of Public Instruction NEILL C. MACDONALD. His name will appear on the Nonpartisan School ballot, which will be handed to the voters separately. Mark an "X" opposite his name.

THE LEAGUE HAS NOT INDORSED ANY CANDIDATES OTHER THAN THE CANDIDATES FOR STATE OFFICES WHOSE NAMES APPEAR ON THE BALLOT, THE CANDIDATES MENTIONED ABOVE AND THE CANDIDATES FOR THE STATE LEGISLATURE WHOSE NAMES APPEAR ELSEWHERE. NO INDORSEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE FOR COUNTY OR LOCAL OFFICES. ANY REPRESENTATIONS TO THE CONTRARY MADE BY CANDIDATES ARE FALSE.
