
This is the tremendous power of the courts. It is a despotic power and a tyrannous power if it is used wrongly.

The judges can not be controlled by the people after they have taken office. Often they CAN BE CONTROLLED BY THE CORPORATIONS IF THE CORPORATIONS PUT THEM INTO POWER.

The people's ONLY SAFETY is to elect judges who are not

BOUND BY BIG BUSINESS. The people's only safety is to elect judges who will be FAIR TO THE PEOPLE.

The trouble with the courts is that the people have been BLIND in their selection of judges. The people have thought that if they elected EMINENT LAWYERS they would have GOOD JUDGES.

That has not been the case. EMINENT LAWYERS too often are CORPORATION ATTORNEYS. They are men trained to think of PROPERTY FIRST and to hold human rights and human lives SECOND IN IMPORTANCE. Judges of this sort are not likely to DO JUSTICE TO THE POOR MAN. The rich command the ABLEST LAWYERS and the ABLEST LAWYERS are able to

SWAY THE COURTS to their way of thinking. CORPORATION ATTORNEYS are trained to attach much importance to LEGAL TECHNICALITIES. Too often the judges THINK THE SAME WAY.

The state needs to elect judges who will PUT HUMAN RIGHTS FIRST. The state needs to elect judges NOT CHOSEN BY THE CORPORATIONS.

There are THREE CANDIDATES in this election who WERE NOT CHOSEN BY THE CORPORATIONS. These candidates are those INDORSED BY THE NONPARTISAN LEAGUE. These are the PEOPLE'S CANDIDATES. Their names are BIRDZELL, GRACE AND ROBINSON.

These three judges will DO JUSTICE TO THE POOR MAN AS WELL AS TO THE RICH MAN. They will hold JUSTICE FIRST.

There are THREE JUSTICES TO BE ELECTED. VOTE FOR ALL THREE, BIRDZELL, GRACE AND ROBINSON. VOTE THE JUDICIARY BALLOT FIRST.
