

Honorable Lynn Frazier's Remarks in Speech at Dickinson

"I don't think there is any trouble but that this amendment for the Dickinson Normal School will carry. I hope so at least. * * * I am sure the coming State Legislature will do the best it can.

"All they have to do is get it before the people, that they want a Normal School out here and need one, and I don't think there will be any trouble but that they will get it."

Mr. Macdonald says: "You can tell them for me I am in favor of a Normal School in Dickinson for the benefit of the people of the Slope country." One thing Mr. Macdonald stands for is educational qualifications for teachers. He believes however, where a teacher has spent her time getting an education, she should have the benefit over those that have not had that training.

NOTE: In order to vote to give the Slope a Normal School you must vote the separate ballot containing an amendment to the Constitution of the State "establishing and locating a State Normal School at Dickinson in the County of Stark."
