

WILMAR STREET FAIR AND HARVEST HOME FESTIVAL, SEPT. 26, 27, 28.

Corrected List of Cash Premiums Offered by the Street Fair Management.

ANNOUNCEMENT.

The Village of Willmar and its people, anxious to all people a cordial invitation to attend and enjoy the Annual Free Street Fair at Willmar to be held Thursday, Friday and Saturday, Sept. 26, 27 and 28, 1901.

PREMIUMS.

The premiums offered for exhibit are, as can be seen from the list, attractive enough to warrant the belief that there will be a general competition for them.

AMUSEMENTS.

The programme of amusements is not yet complete but from the arrangements already made it is no exaggeration to predict that it will surpass anything of the kind yet presented in Willmar.

PRIZES IMMEDIATELY.

The giving of prizes will be completed on the last day of the fair and all who have won will be given orders by the secretary which will be on file with the prizes.

RULES.

- SEC. 1. All articles entered to compete for premiums must have the secretary's entry card attached.
SEC. 2. All poultry offered in competition must be owned by the exhibitor or some member of the family.
SEC. 3. The exhibitors are required to have their articles entered on the books of the secretary and arranged at the designated places before 12 o'clock noon on Thursday, Sept. 26th.
SEC. 4. Exhibitors will be entitled to exhibit any number of articles; but in no case can the same article be entered to compete for premiums in more than one lot.
SEC. 5. The removal of articles before 5 o'clock p. m. on Saturday, Sept. 28, will forfeit any premium awarded.
SEC. 6. Each division superintendent has complete charge of all exhibits in his division and his authority should be respected accordingly.
SEC. 7. Judges are barred from exhibiting in the class in which they are judges.
SEC. 8. Competitors attempting to interfere with judges will forfeit their right to a premium and should in all cases be reported by the committee to the secretary.
SEC. 9. Judges will report decisions to the secretary, who will give an order to the proper party calling for premiums.
SEC. 10. Where there is only one exhibitor, in one lot, number, only one premium will be given to the first, second or third, as the merit of the article may warrant.
SEC. 11. Awards of premiums will be designated by cards as follows: First prize, blue; second, red; third, yellow; fourth, green.
SEC. 12. The owner of the exhibit to which a premium card is attached will receive an order on the treasurer for the prize by calling at the secretary's office.
SEC. 13. All exhibits will be passed upon at 2 o'clock p. m., Saturday, Sept. 29th.
SEC. 14. The amount of grain and vegetables to be exhibited will be one bushel, except melons, pumpkins, squash, radishes, marrows, etc., one each.
SEC. 15. Exhibitors must see to the proper delivery of articles, and to the proper care of same, as no charge of transportation will be paid by the management.
SEC. 16. The managers will take every precaution in their power for the protection and security of articles exhibited, but will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
SEC. 17. Fire and police regulations will be provided and as ample force will be on hand to see that the regulations are strictly observed.

the grounds, and the owners of the property required to pay charges. Sec. 18. Only residents in Kandiyohi county can compete for premiums.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS.

Persons residing some distance away are requested to make out a list of the articles they wish entered designating the class in which they desire them placed, signing their name plainly and send to the secretary by mail, and entry cards will be ready, or call at the office of the secretary on first day of the Fair. Persons living in or near town should call and have their entries made before the first day of the Fair.

RULES GOVERNING EXHIBITS.

- 1. Chickens will compete in classes by themselves in each breed and receive the same value in premiums as old fowls.
2. All entries must be made in pairs. Each entry must state whether chicks or fowls. The term "fowl" is a bird hatched prior to 1901; "chick" is a bird hatched during 1901. Chick weight made before the first day of the Fair.
3. All stock must be entered in the name of the actual owner.
4. An expert judge will be selected to make the awards and the American standard of perfection shall govern in all varieties recognized therein.
5. The judge will award no premiums to fowls or birds disqualified or improperly classed or named. Owners must abide by their designation of the class and name they enter in.
No entries will be received after 12 m., Thursday, Sept. 26th, 1901.
A pen must consist of no less than four hens and rooster.
