

Town and Village Elections.

Tuesday, March 14, is town meeting day, when the voters of each township meet to elect officers for the year and act upon report of town finances, levy town taxes, etc.

Besides the twenty-four town meetings of the county there are six villages that hold their annual election on that day, viz., Atwater, Kandiyohi, New London, Leacock, Raymond and Spicer.

In several of these villages the question whether or not to license liquor selling will come up for decision by a direct vote by the citizens. In one or two of these municipalities the question will be voted upon for the first time.

If the wishes of the people living in the country tributary to the villages in Kandiyohi county were consulted, the vote would stand overwhelmingly against the legalizing of the traffic.


