A good auditorium would be a great improvement to the city and be a source of revenue which would eventually pay for the bonds.

Provision could also be made for room for the telephone exchange in case the city should find it necessary to take it over and operate it.

In short, unless there is some pretty well grounded reason to believe that the proceeds of the bonds will be expended for practical necessities and not mere ornaments, it will be better to vote down the bonds.

Thus it will be seen that there are three propositions on which every voter has and should have the right of knowing how stands every candidate for an administrative office in the city of Willmar this spring.
