The County Board In Special Session

State of Minnesota,) ss. County of Kandiyohi,) Office of County Auditor, Willmar, Minn., Nov. 25, 1910.

The Board of County Commissioners of said county convened in adjourned special session this date at 2 o'clock p. m. pursuant to adjournment. The following members were present: Commissioners Johnson, Kloster and Swenson and chairman Olson.

Whereas, the waters of Foot Lake, a navigable lake situated wholly within the township of Willmar, County of Kandiyohi and state of Minnesota, have become and are low, leaving said lake in a non-navigable and unhealthy condition and state, and having determined by competent survey and oral evidence that the present stage of waters in said lake is far below the normal level or height, and there being a general demand on the part of the public to have said waters established, raised and maintained at a uniform height; and,

Whereas, the Board deems it necessary for the promotion of public health and public welfare, and for the improvement of navigation on said lake, to establish and maintain a uniform height of the waters in said lake; and,

Now, Therefore, Be It Heretby Resolved, of the promotion of the public health and welfare, and for the improvement of navigation on said Foot Lake, that the waters of said lake be raised, established and maintained at a uniform height and that such height be and hereby is fixed and determined at a level fourteen (14) inches over and above that particular water level found to exist and was on the 13th day of April, A. D. 1910, as found by an actual survey thereof by N. Y. Taylor, Esq., of Litchfield, Minnesota, Engineer, which water level was 3.96 feet below the bench mark placed by said Engineer on the top of the south east corner of the stone abutments of the bridge that spans the outlet of said lake;

Be It Resolved, Further, that to maintain such level and holding that there be erected and maintained a dam at the outlet of said Foot Lake, located about 200 feet South of the North line of Lot three and about 700 feet East of the West line of said Lot three in section 16, Township 119, Range 35, such dam to be of the necessary height to maintain such level with a spillway sufficiently wide
