Railroad Discrimination Against the Smaller Cities and the Common People.

Mr. Editor:

Your editorial about the late raise of fare in this State prompts me to relate the following:

On the morning of the Fourth I went to Milton, Wis., to deliver a 4th of July address. On the train out of St. Paul the discussion was centered on the late raise of passenger rate. And attention was called by several gentlemen to the outrageous discrimination against the public in general under the 3 cent rate. Judge Sanborn held that it was necessary to return to the 3 cent fare and it has been said that the roads had to do it.

Of course the roads did not have to return to the 3 cent rate, because they are not charging 3 cents a mile to every body. If a person has the leisure and the money to make ten trips to the cities a year, such a person is only charged 2 cents per mile, while the person who only makes 4 trips must pay 3 cents per mile. If a person wants to go to Willmar, Litchfield or St. Cloud to spend the Fourth he had to pay 3 cents per mile, while if he wanted to go to Minneapolis to spend it it was only 2 cents a mile.

This brutal discrimination against persons and places by the railroads is one of the worst crimes against the public today. The American public wants fair play. But it is not waking up to the fact that it is not getting fair play in this matter; that this railroad discrimination against persons and places is a monstrous wrong that must be righted one way or another.

As a man in Minneapolis said: "There are tens of thousands of women and children in the cities who would like to get out and visit their relatives in the smaller towns in the state this sweltering 4th of July, but the railroads said: '3 cents per mile'. It is enough to make an ordinary loyal American citizen an anarchist."

The remedy for this outrageous discrimination against persons and places is not to increase the gross earnings tax—though, God knows, we ordinary people pay more than four times the rate on our taxable property that the railroads do—but to pass a rigid distance tariff law, freight and passenger, let the effect be what it may in other respects. The Governor ought to call an extra session of the legislature at once to enact such a law without delay.

As a man said: "The 3 cent rate was not re-enacted to enable the roads to earn more money—the earnings under it would be less—but to enable the roads to give special favors to cities and their friends."

And this happens in the year of American Independence 135. Dr. Christian Johnson.
