the use of pure bred sires of the right quality as far as possible and by agreeing to make Kandiyohi county a live stock county.

Article V.

Amendments.—This constitution may be amended by a majority vote of members present at any regular meeting.

By-Laws K. C. L. S. Breeders' Association.

Sec. 1.—The annual membership dues shall be one dollar paid in advance.

Sec. 2.—Regular meetings shall be held at least twice per year and special meetings may be held at the call of the executive committee or by a petition from the majority of members.

Sec. 3.—The President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer shall constitute the executive committee.

Sec. 4.—Other committees shall be appointed from time to time as deemed advisable by the members.

Sec. 5.—Each member is expected to use as far as possible good pure bred sires.

Sec. 6.—The association shall publish annually a list of the breeders of good live stock who are members and a list of the kind and number of stock they have for sale.

Sec. 7.—This association shall endeavor to push the gospel of better live stock in the county to such an extent that local buyers may be able to secure high class stock without sending their money outside of the county.

Sec. 8.—In order to better promote the interests of good stock breeders this association shall maintain a County Live Stock Bureau which shall endeavor to aid in all ways the improvement of stock within the county and shall aim to provide the necessary means of publicity and distribution of information.

Sec. 9.—Recommended that all using letter heads have the names and addresses of the officers of this association printed thereon and that officers be furnished with stationery.

Sec. 10.—Roberts rules of order shall govern this organization in the transaction of business.

Sec. 11.—These by-laws may be amended by a majority vote at any regular meeting.
