A NEW TIME CARD NOVEMBER 2

How the Coming Changes Will Affect Trains at Breckenridge.

Breckenridge Telegram.—The long awaited time card which will send the Great Northern's fast mail and passenger trains over the new Fargo-Surrey cutoff, is expected to go into effect Nov. 2. Supt. F. D. Kelsey of the Breckenridge division has been in St. Paul this week in consultation over the final particulars.

The change makes New Rockford instead of Devils Lake the terminus of this division for the passenger trains. Train No. 4 which leaves here at 4 o'clock P. M. eastbound from the coast will hereafter run over the Fergus division. Train No. 2 will run over this line instead but will be of no use to local passengers as its time here will be 12:50 A. M., an hour after the time of No. 10, whose time will not be changed. Coast train No. 3, westbound, will leave this city at about the same time, 5:20 A. M., running via Casselton, Bedford and New Rockford, No. 2 will come via New Rockford and Fargo. Fast mail No. 27 will leave on its present schedule, running via Fargo and New Rockford. No. 28, the east bound fast mail, will come over the same route, arriving here at 6:25 A. M. Other passenger schedules and all of the freight schedules remain practically unchanged.

The new arrangement will not make any difference in the number of crews stationed here. The passenger crews on trains 2 and 3 will have their layover here instead of at other end as at present. They will leave here on No. 3 in the morning and return at midnight on No. 2.

The use of the Surrey line will cut off several hours in the time of the Great Northern's coast bound trains.
