DRY'S WON OUT IN SEVEN MORE COUNTIES
Very Close Call in Meeker County. Only Three Wet Counties Left in Seventh.
The dry forces made a clean sweep in the seven counties that voted on the liquor question Monday. Early returns from Meeker county seemed to indicate that our neighbor to the east had gone wrong, and there was much regret expressed yesterday at the Old Settlers' picnic at Atwater on this supposed result, but late returns show that the county went dry by only 18 votes majority.
Big Stone, Pope and Meeker were three more Seventh District counties to go dry, leaving only three which have not voted in the district. Stevens and Chippewa vote next Monday, and we hope our neighbors will exert every effort to contribute to make the Seventh District dry all thru. The results Monday were as follows: Meeker, 1575 to 1557, 18 majority. Big Stone, 253 majority. Wright, 3,077 to 2,601, 476 majority. Pennington, 1518 to 1,118, 400 majority. Pope, 1,000 majority. Wadena, 400 or more majority. Marshall, 800 majority or better. Seven counties will vote next Monday—Martin, Stevens, Houston, Chippewa, Pine, Mille Lacs and Fairbault. To date 32 counties have gone dry and four wet.
