ORDINANCE NO. 160.

An Ordinance to Regulate the Carrying of Passengers for Hire Within the Limits of the City of Willmar, Minnesota. It is ordained by the City of Willmar that the City Clerk shall issue licenses for hire within said city, upon paying the license fee therefor, hereinafter fixed, and obtaining a license for each and every such vehicle, and complying with and observing all the provisions of this ordinance.

Two classes of licenses may be issued under this ordinance, one a general license for the term of one year from the date of issue, to apply to all vehicles used for sight seeing purposes, or rented from a public or private garage, and the destination and route of travel under the license of such passenger or passengers transported therein; the other, a special license to operate vehicles between certain definite points or termini, and to be so held out, advertised or announced.

Each license herein provided for, shall be signed by the Mayor and City Clerk, with the official seal of the City of Willmar, and shall have a number to be selected by said City Clerk, by which said license shall be designated and known, and in case of a special license, shall give the route to be traveled, the terminal points of such route and the rate of fare to be charged, provided, however, that the Mayor and City Clerk shall issue no license where the driver thereof is known to be a user of drugs or intoxicants.


