ADJOURNED SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNTY BOARD.

Office of County Auditor, Willmar, Minn., June 11, 1918.

The County Board convened on above date at 2 o'clock P. M. All members of the Board present. The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Pursuant to motion duly given the Board proceeded to open bids received for the construction of State Bridge No. 2744, situated on the highway in the town of Willmar said County.

The following bids were received: J. H. Olson and Co., Willmar, Minn., amount of bid \$175,000; Ekhardt Bridge and Iron Co., Minneapolis, Minn., amount of bid \$175,000.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, the bid of J. H. Olson and Co. was accepted and contract entered into with said J. H. Olson and Co. for the construction of said State Bridge No. 2744.

W. J. De Vries of Roseland township and H. J. Rocchio of Holland township, and the town Boards of the towns of Holland and Roseland, appeared before the Board in the matter of a proposed State Road to run thru the townships of East Lake Lillian, Lake Lillian, Roseland and Holland, and the Board duly heard in the matter. The Board decided to take the matter under consideration.

On motion Commissioners Boersma and Swenson were appointed County Commissioners.

FROM RECRUITING OFFICER

Major Yost Says This is a Young Man's War. Many are Enlisting.

With the closing of the public schools in Minnesota a general increase in Army recruiting throughout the state is looked for by Major John D. Yost, recruiting officer for the Minnesota District. There are hundreds of high school boys in the state who have only been awaiting the end of the school term before getting into service. High School boys in Minnesota have not been slow in answering the call of the country, and there is hardly a school in any town in the state which is not represented in one or another of Uncle Sam's fighting forces.

In most instances credits have been awarded boys who have enlisted, by the school authorities, and many of them have been sent to industrial training schools in various sections of the country. "The present struggle is preeminently a young man's war," said Major Yost, "and it is plainly evident that the young men of the state appreciate that fact to the fullest extent. The recent draft registration of young men who attained the age of 21 years, after June 5, 1917, showed conclusively that young men have been answering the call of the country in large numbers. The number of men registered June 5th this year fell 25 percent below the estimated figures, showing that at least that percentage of the men of 21 years had enlisted.

It is generally believed that the same figure will hold good for men between the ages of 18 and 21, as they have been flocking to the colors in ever increasing numbers. The young men of today are afforded wonderful opportunities in the Army. There are no stumbling blocks in his way and no limit to what he may attain. Officers now are picked from the men in the ranks, in the fairest and most impartial manner that could be devised. The need of men is urgent for the Regular Army, and that is the place for every red blooded American today."

BOARD OF EDUCATION

Willmar, Minnesota, June 3, 1918.

The regular meeting of the Board of Education of Independent School District No. 47 of Willmar, Minn., was held at the Bank of Willmar on Monday, June 3rd, 1918 at four o'clock a.m.

Members present, Lawson, Qvale, Olsson, Carlson and Swenson. Absent, O'Toerness.

Supt. Foster was also present.

The meeting was called to order by the President and the minutes of the foregoing regular meeting and the special meeting read and approved. The following bills were presented, audited by the Finance Committee and upon motion approved and ordered paid: V. S. Nelson Brothers laundry, \$50.00; G. A. Foster, express, postage etc. 22.55; Elsie Marvall, milk, 1.75; City of Willmar, light and water, 38.17; Palm Bakery, milk, 1.00; White Star, music, 6.74; W. H. Dyer & Brother, music, 6.33.

The Building Committee upon motion authorized to purchase coal for the coming school year. Ben Eddy Carlson was upon motion elected to take the School census as provided by Law, and to organize and appoint members selected to take care of the school lawns during the summer vacation at a salary of \$25.00 per month for such care as needed.

Member S. B. Qvale offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

Whereas the Board of Education of Independent School District No. 47 of Kandiyohi County, Minnesota did on the 12th day of March 1918 pass certain motions accepting the Conditional bids of the following named persons for the construction of a new High School building, and for alterations of buildings now on the school premises, namely: Macdonald Construction Co., Ben Eddy Carlson and Sterling Electric Company, and whereas the said Independent School District No. 47 of Kandiyohi County, Minnesota did on the 12th day of April, 1918 at a special election held for that purpose vote the additional bonds of said School District in the sum of \$40,000 for the purpose of constructing said school building above referred to, and whereas the Board of Investment of the State of Minnesota, by reason of certain acts of the federal Government has refused and does refuse to approve of the said school election and the making of bonds for the purpose of constructing a new building or to remodel the buildings now on the school premises, by reason of the said acts of the federal Government, and whereas the Board of Education of Independent School District No. 47 of Kandiyohi
