THE TRIP WEST

One of County's "Seventy-One" Writes of the Trip to Camp Lewis.

Camp Lewis, Wash. June 10, 1918.

Editor Willmar Tribune:

Dear Sir:

From the attitude of a person of more or less leisure to one ushered into a position where commands are law is a vicissitude that is very apparent and not to be passed into without notice. Such, however, was my experience as one of the "71" that left Willmar on May 25th last.

Leaving home and friends was not entirely an easy matter and was not accomplished without a feeling of emotion. However the glad handshakes and farewell wishes of the numerous friends that had gathered to see us off were a stimulant and encouragement to resolve to go and do the duties that had been imposed upon us with a strong determination to make the most of it.

The trip to our training camp at Camp Lewis, Tacoma, Washington was one full of thrills and adventure. To a Minnesotan and especially to a resident of Kandiyohi county, who is used to fertile fields, surrounded by beautiful lakes, streams and forests, it would seem that a trip of this nature would be void of interest, but such is not the case. To one who has never seen it before even the sight of barren and devastated land was of interest and attention not to mention the superb and sublime scenes that you behold as the big mountains loom up in the distance with their white caps of snow and then as you near them and begin to wind around them, making the train look like a snake as it winds its way around and about with streams and swift current and waterfalls of rustling waters everywhere visible is a sight of wonder and consternation that even the most stout and indolent personage could behold without a feeling of amazement at the grandeur of nature's wonderful handiwork.

Our train scheduled, however, was not arranged entirely to suit a tourist (Uncle Sam didn't have this object in

mind) for we went thru the Rocky Mountains and the Glacier National Park during the night and was also the case in part when going thru the Cascades, but in this latter case the forepart of the evening was spent viewing the strange break of nature work. Here we went thru a four mile tunnel.

A mountain range is very elusive and misleading. One is very apt to think that the mountain you are viewing is much nearer than in reality is the fact. As an illustration, at Leavenworth, Wash., a town at the foot of the Cascade mountains, we made a short stop and it was there that we saw the mountains were but a couple of city blocks away but was told by the residents of the town that they were four miles away.

To me the most interesting part of our trip was our travel between Willow Creek and Wenatchee, Wash. Here we went thru the most gorgeous and beautiful scenery that one could ever wish to see, constantly winding about along a swift running river and excellently high sand hills and with the sun just setting in the distance and the hills on the hills and water made a golden panorama long to be remembered.

On the immediate bank of this river all along was orchards of apple trees. The reason for planting orchards on river bank is in order to have easy access to water for irrigation, the water being pumped up from the river. Another reason for so placing the orchards (probably the chief one) is because there was no place to plant it for the sand hills would grow no apples.

Wenatchee is famous for its apples and boasts of being the home of the red apple.

We arrived at Tacoma early Tuesday morning the 28th, a few hours ahead of our schedule. After a few hours wait here we were taken out to Camp Lewis, American Lake, and got our first glimpse at the place that we are sojourning at. It was a sight to behold. A large number of humanity where every thing is executed with speed and snap, in fact make it a word that is much in vogue with the officers and it being lived up to in every respect. We got our uniform and gun practically as soon as we got there and were immediately out to drilling.

The officers tell us that we are to do work in a month's time that took them a year to do. The men are splendid that were here before us, and I believe they mean it for we sure are working hard.

We are in strict quarantine so we have had no opportunity to explore the camp as a whole. They however, took us out one day on a seven mile hike in which is known here as "no man's land." Here we saw trenches of all kinds of shape and manner and every thing else that is suitable to the essence of modern warfare training.

All of us Kandiyohi county boys, with the exception of a few that volunteered for the spruce cutting camp at Vancouver and have gone there, are in the 24th Co. In what is known as the Depot Brigade and which is really only a distribution place. After a month's stay here we will be assigned to regular companies and then undoubtedly we will all be separated.

It was my pleasure to see the strange phenomena of a total eclipse of the sun here last Saturday afternoon at about 4 o'clock. To see the sun disappear and get dark in the midst of day and not a cloud visible is a rare thing and something that don't happen very often.

In conclusion, a trip to the west is very interesting and enjoyable, but only as such. For me give me good old Minnesota and a particular spot, Kandiyohi county and it suffices.
