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INFORMATION IN REGARD CONTROL OF MEASLES

Danger of This Disease is Greatest to Younger Children. Care Must Be Taken

Dear Doctor: So far as the measles to which you refer is concerned, would the publication of the enclosed article in your local newspaper be of any service to you in controlling this disease?

Measles is at present becoming increasingly prevalent. It is very catching and very dangerous to children under five years of age.

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Every care should be taken to prevent children from catching measles. Protect your little ones and help others protect their children from catching measles.

At the beginning measles resembles an ordinary heavy cold in the head or chest. It is very catching at this stage. The rash does not appear until a few days later.

It is important that children who have not had this disease and who have been exposed to it should be taken to school, to a neighbor's house, or to attend any public assembly, as they may spread this disease to others.

Notify the Health Officer of any known or suspected cases of measles of which you are aware.

Parents should inform teachers and explain the reasons for absences of all school children. If an illness proves to be measles, a doctor should be called to see the patient as complications may set in—even in the very mild cases—and chance a mild case into a severe or fatal case.

The sick child should be kept in a quiet, well-ventilated room, away from other children, especially all under five years of age.

Children who have had measles may safely go to school from a house where measles exists, if they were the only child there and carefully provided, of course that they are kept away from the measles case while they are at home.

Children who have not had the measles cannot safely go to school from a home where measles exists.

To avoid catching measles never go near any one who has measles. This disease infects strong as well as the weak, the robust as well as the sickly, attacking all alike.
