

BY A REDUCED MAJORITY.

THE NORTH STAR STATE IS REPUBLICAN.

While Nelson's Vote Shows a Decided Decrease Over That Cast Four Years Ago, Republican Gain in the Legislature.

One of Many.

St. Paul, Special Telegram, Nov. 10.—Chairman Jamison, of the Republican state central committee, is confident that the Republican party has elected Kaute Nelson governor by a large plurality—about 20,000. There are indications that there has been a large falling off in the People's party vote, and the majority of the slumping vote has gone largely back to the Republican party. Chairman Jamison said last night that the returns are coming in slowly, but those which have been received have given the committee every reason to expect a handsome plurality for their candidate for governor.

In the southern part of the state he has received a very large vote, and in the Alliance districts in the northwestern part of the state he made a big cut into the Owen vote of two years ago. In Norman county two years ago Gov. Merriam received only 309 votes, and Owen 1,046; but Mr. Nelson goes out of Norman county this election with a plurality of 25. In Dodge county, in the southern part of the state, where Gov. Merriam had a plurality of 278 over the Owen vote two years ago, Kaute Nelson, it is said, will receive a plurality of over 600 votes. The committee feels that a good majority of the congressmen are elected. O. M. Hall's election in the Third district is not conceded.
