Ada Index: Recently Bevers & Griewe superintended shipment of a carload of sweet clover seed from Ada, consigned to H. J. Mayer at Lincoln, Ill. Mr. Bevers has received word that the freight bill was \$807. There was 66,403 pounds of clover seed in the car, which is 1107 bushels. Making the freight charge about 55 cents-per bushel. The railways did not lack nerve when they fixed the rate of clover seed. Most of the seed in this shipment was not hulled and cleaned, and as seed direct from the thresher loses 25 per cent in cleaning it shows that it pays big to clean the seed before shipment. On this car about \$150 freight was paid for hauling dirt.
