

A LITTLE WHEAT BULGE

Unfavorable Weather Reports and a More Pacific Labor Outlook are the Cause of It.

And a Favorable Construction of the Government Crop Report Helped the Mild Boom Along.

Wall Street Characterized by a Lifeless and Featureless Market With a Bearish Tendency.

Which was Particularly Marked in Western Union—Gossip From the Maris of Trade.

CHICAGO, March 11.—Despite the continued mild, spring-like weather, there was a little boom in wheat today. Prices went up at a single jump 5/8 right at the opening of business. Trading all the forenoon was at a higher range than yesterday's close, yet the feeling was nervous and the crowd so orderly cramped with conflicting news and reports of various kinds that nobody would have been surprised if the bottom had fallen out of the market any minute. It was a typical March day, closing at yesterday's latest price, which was the price of the day on the curb as full of "wise saws and modern inventions," and nearly everybody turns stationary, the wheat market in the west goes on. Meanwhile the market looks weak to some people, as prices are being marked up, and strong to others, as the low and steady prices of the blackboard are going down. Pronounced among the bull features this morning were the various reports of unfavorable weather for winter wheat in the Southwest, firm cables, and the more
