at the usual hour, but the customers that passed through their doors were few and the clerks stood at the doors discussing in sad voice the terrible visitation of death that will never be forgotten so long as St. Cloud is known as a dwelling place of human beings. Business was

AT A STANDSTILL and the usual jar and rattle of the streets had given way to the suppressed murmur of voices, as the citizens gathered in knots on the corners and discussed the various phases of the terrible calamity that had come so suddenly upon them, and so completely shrouded the city in a pall of gloom. The fortunate ones who lived beyond the path of the whirlwind of death and destruction kindly remembered the afflicted ones, and the ladies became nurses and turned their attention to the alleviation of the sufferings of their neighbors. Many homes had been swept out of existence by the terrible and relentless train of the aerial demon, and the owners were spared their lives but found but little to be grateful for in the broken walls of their once happy homes.

THE SITUATION. All day long people have been arriving in the city from different parts of the country, and to-night the hotels are filled to overflowing and 'coots in the hall' even are hard to get. Farmers have come in from surrounding districts by scores, and apparently have no other business than to look over the ground so lately visited by the cloud of devastation and stand around corpses and comment on their appearance. Saloons are doing a land-office business and restaurants are driven to their utmost to accommodate the hordes of hungry visitors. The Grand Central hotel is headquarters and the rotunda is crowded. The chief topic of conversation is the terrible calamity. While St. Cloud is accorded its share of sympathy, Sauk Rapids is given the preponderance of pity, as the condition of its citizens is

MUCH WORSE than that of the former place. The report comes from the lower portion of Douglas county, just south of Alexandria, that three farm houses were torn to shreds by the wind, but there is no intimation that there was loss of life. Farmers from the northwest part of the county tell almost incredible stories of finding remnants of buildings on their property, twenty miles distant from this city, and portions of organs and pianos have been picked up fifteen miles from the city and brought in as curiosities. Prairie, a mile northwest of the track of the cyclone, is full of pieces of plank driven a foot or more into the ground, which gives a limited idea of the terrible force with which they must have been driven by the wind. The freakish disposition of the tornado is evident in cases where small kitchens were

TAKEN FROM THE BODY of the house and carried hundreds of feet without disturbing the main structure in the least. Dogs were found with scalps torn from their skulls as neatly as could have been done by the scalpel, and

small houses are now standing with chimneys torn off, while larger buildings but a few rods away were so badly rent and scattered that only the cellar remain to show where they stood. The sides of many of the buildings are pierced with heavy splinters that tore a hole through thick walls only large enough to allow them to enter, and they protrude like huge pegs. In the walls of other buildings holes are noticeable that seem to have been made by cannon balls. Panels have been torn from doors, and with this exception the buildings seem to have been untouched. In other houses window panes have been torn out and the sash untouched. The walls of many of the dwellings have a

BLACKENED APPEARANCE, as though they had been fired and badly smoked. It is estimated that forty families are homeless and are in destitute circumstances, and relief is badly needed. This morning flags were hung at half-mast and more than one door bore the emblem of death that fluttered in the stiff southwest breeze as though anxious to attract the attention of passers by. Preparations are being made for the burial of the dead, and the bodies of those who were members of the Catholic church, both here and in Sauk Rapids, will be collected in the basement of the cathedral in this city and funeral services held to-morrow at 9 o'clock a. m. Funeral services will also be conducted in Immaculate Conception church at 8 o'clock to-morrow morning. Funeral services will also be held to-morrow at 2 o'clock p. m., at the residence of the late Edgar Hull, president of the German-American National bank. His remains will be taken to Kalamazoo, Mich., where his wife and children now are. Teams have been engaged here to go to Sauk Rapids to-morrow morning at 8 o'clock for removal of bodies. Ex-Gov. Gilman's house stood almost in the direct line of the cyclone, but was uninjured. His family saw it approaching and ran

INTO THE CELLAR. The only loss suffered by Mr. Gilman was one horse. A box car was picked up from the track and blown three blocks and dropped into a ravine. Pen is utterly powerless to paint a picture that will give the reader the perfect idea of the condition of affairs. Men are here who have lost every dollar's worth of property that they owned, and added to this affliction many of them have to bear the load of grief caused by the calamitous death of dear friends or relatives. Yesterday afternoon a committee appointed by the jobbers' union of St. Paul arrived in the city with a carload of provisions to be distributed among the needy, and blankets and mattresses were telegraphed for and will probably be here to-morrow. Joseph Junglen now lies at the hospital, both legs

being broken and his body badly bruised, while in their collins lie his three children. Mrs. Junglen was out of the city at the time of the disaster and when she returned this morning she told her that her children were lying injured at the engine house, and when she went to the house and found the lifeless bodies the scene was heart-rending. Mayor Ames sent two physicians, in charge of Dr. J. T. Moore, this morning to Rice's station to offer their services to the afflicted in that vicinity.

FOURTEEN MILES AWAY. As showing the force of the wind, the sign board in length that was formerly on the Manitoba depot was found to-day in a field fourteen miles from where it started. A metallic stamp used in the flour mill here was found in the same field.
