WASHINGTON, June 3.--Maj. Henderson, of Minneapolis, called at the postoffice department to-day and was introduced to Postmaster General Vilas.

Col. Vilas has made no decision in regard to the Minneapolis postoffice. The office seems to be between Henderson and Glenn.

At the meeting of the citizens of the city, it is expected that a copy of the resolutions be furnished his honor the mayor and the public press.

Resolved, That it is the sense of this meeting, representing seven-eighths of the taxpayers of the city, that his honor the mayor of Minneapolis be requested to direct the enforcement of the postoffice law.

Whereas, As we think this request is just and upright in the eyes of the citizens of the commonwealth, it is directed that a copy of these resolutions be furnished his honor the mayor and the public press.

The secretary was instructed to wait upon Mayor Ames, who is expected to arrive from the East to-day, and request him to take action in accordance with the spirit of the resolutions.

It is expected that all steps will be closed Sunday with the exception of those of the West and Nicollet hotels, run by the Bros., who propose to keep open for the purpose of making a test case.

The penalty prescribed by the voters of the city is to be in jail, for from one to five days in jail, or both, at the discretion of the court.
