

THE MARKETS EASTERN.

Both Wheat and Corn Record a Slight Decline on the Chicago Board of Trade.

Belief That the Backbone of the Drouth is Broken Weakens Holders of Corn.

New York Buying Imparts More of the Strength to Wheat-Provisions Firm and Higher.

Stocks Higher, Vanderbilt Shares Leading and Grangers Following on Better Crop Reports.

CHICAGO, July 31.—About the usual Saturday market prevailed to-day, which is equivalent to a statement that prices were easier and averaged rather lower, as in a general way the wheat crop, the same as corn traders, are "long" more or less stuff, which they do not feel disposed, under the circumstances, to carry over Sunday. In the corn situation would have been more bullish if there had not been a little rain recently. This has weakened holders a little and induced the belief that the backbone of the drouth may be broken. Reports to-day, however, agree that no rain in any great quantity has fallen in the corn belt since yesterday. The top of the corn market was at the opening of the session. On the open board it is said to have sold between 4 1/2c and 4 3/4c. The curb was 4 1/2c. The regular market was opened at 4 1/2c. Some sold at 4 1/2c. Counselman was taking in about all the corn he could get early in the day. Crosby, Norton, Worthington, Leslie, Pickering, and others gave him lots varying in size from 10,000 to 45,000 bushels.

WHEN THE MARKET REACTED to 4 1/2c, again strengthened and sold at 4 3/4c, then broke to 4 1/2c, and during the latter part of the session ruled rather slow and featureless. Receipts here were 384 cars, which was about the average. At times wheat showed moderate strength, but it came from the outside rather than from any friendship shown the market in a local way. Milling, Bodman & Pitten and other houses had a few firm connections did the bulk of the buying, presumably on New York account. September opened at 77c, sagged down to 7 1/2c, and was then forced up to 7 3/4c, and from that point went straight off to 7 5/8c, and toward the close hung doggedly around 7 7/8c. Receipts here 233 cars. There was little float in the way of news, yesterday morning being the only day when the market was not taken in the direction in which it was forced by purely local influence. Early buyers were free sellers toward 1 o'clock, crowding September down to 7 5/8c, but it recovered a little toward 2 o'clock. Ten boat loads were reported taken at New York. Provisions of all kinds were firm, though not keeping up the whole advance. September pork sold up to \$10.25, but reacted to \$10.12 1/2.
