

THE CIVIL SERVICE SQUABBLE

Ex-Commissioner Eaton Makes a Reply to Bishop Oberly.

The Latter, He Says, Was Ignorant, and, Therefore, Innocent.

New York, Sept. 11.—In a letter to the Times ex-Civil Service Commissioner Dorman B. Eaton says:

In a former letter I promised to answer specifically all the charges which Commissioner Oberly has made. The first and principal charge is that, in making a special rule approved July 22, 1884, in conducting examinations and in making general certificates thereunder for the position of special examiners for the pension office. Concerning the certificates and appointments for pension examiners, the law is very plain and was this, that when the commission made the certificates for their appointment it found it necessary to certify the names of all applicants on its registers, instead of only the four marked highest as the rules required in other cases. The appointing officer could, therefore, at his discretion, with which they could not interfere, select from the whole list instead of being compelled to take one from each set of four.

THIS RULE OF FOUR as rigidly enforced in every case until July, 1884, save one exception for imperative reasons was always made to a few technical places in the state department. On the 7th of that month, and the last day of its session, congress, adjourned, having suddenly decided that same day, an amended act creating 150 new offices to be filled, of which the occupants were to be called pension examiners. Contrary to all precedent and to the law as to the other class of examiners, these new examiners were, by the express terms of the new law, to hold office for only one year, and yet to cover them, rigidly required the appointments to them to be appointed among the states and territories in the ratio of population. Mr. Oberly declares, to use his own words, "that it was provided that these officers should be appointed under the law, and not act by examination and certification." TO SET OFF A PLACE OF ONE YEAR TO ONE STATE against appointments to other states for an indefinite time. The request for certificates to fill the places, and to be known to the public, was made on July 8. In that exigency the only thing that could do was to certify in the usual form the names of thirty-two applicants for the existing class of examiners which it was hoped was fairly qualified, and it did so. There was anxious discussion of the perplexing situation presented at that time, and was consulted. He was always firm and faithful for a reform policy. On the 23rd of July the commission advised the attorney-general that the special rule referred to, which Commissioner Oberly holds up to public censure on partisan grounds in his letter to the Times. This policy resulted in reasonably fair places with competent examiners. The enemies of reform were defeated of their spoils and in their hope of discrediting the commissioner.
