he had not done this—how could they ever have collected the tax? The law is not repealed by the rulings and decisions that it is a matter of the most extreme difficulty for two expert lawyers to determine alike as to what the law is. On this point, under discussion, one will say that if the land still belongs to the United States of course it cannot be taxed; and of course if the title has not passed, and if it is possible that owing to some

DEFECT IN THE PROOF it will not pass, it is still the property of the government. But, on the other hand, the rulings that the land that is to be met, notably one of James vs. Schofield, in which the dictum is laid down that where a claimant has made a valid purchase of land, the title and commissions he is entitled to final certificate and has a right to make an agreement to sell the land. On the strength of the rulings and decisions that have been made, it is customary in this and all other land districts for settlers to borrow money at the time of proving up, and the loaners are satisfied with a mortgage on the claim, although title has not actually passed. These money loaners, who are generally to be trusted to see that their security is good, are satisfied with this. The point that satisfies them is the decision that has been affirmed many times after proof has been made, that the title is entitled to a patent. But the new ruling of the department say that he is entitled to it at that time if he is entitled to it at all. In other words, he is held up to the law. Whether or not he complies with that law must be decided by the Washington authorities, and not by the local land office. The register and recorder who take the evidence and record it, are not judges of the adequacy of the proof or at Washington. The matter is a rather complicated one, and will have to be decided as to whether or not a claimant can have a patent is received—in the courts. It has never come up in that shape yet.
