After Big Money. CINCINNATI, O., Aug. 30.—Receiver Armstrong, within the next forty-eight hours, will file in the United States court a civil suit for between \$2,000,000 and \$3,000,000 against Eugene Zimmerman, Henry Pogue, W. H. Chaffield and Briggs Swift, directors in the failed Fidelity National bank, charging them with having betrayed their trust as national bank directors, and claiming that they did not protect their depositors, they are liable under the statute for nearly \$3,000,000, the full amount of the depositors' losses.


