

SOLD UNDER THE HAMMER

Sale of Shorthorns at J. J. Hill's Stock Farm, North Oaks.

LEADING STOCKMEN THERE.

The Sale Aggregated Fourteen Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty Dollars.

Notwithstanding the day was cloudy, the sale of J. J. Hill's Shorthorns at North Oaks yesterday was well attended. There were among the bidders Col. W. S. King and H. F. Brown, of Minneapolis, netted \$13,000 for the forty odd animals which went under the hammer, making an average price of about \$300.

Mr. Hill is very much elated over the promising future of the Milk river country in Montana as a cattle raising section.

After luncheon the breeders repaired to the sale sheds, where Col. J. W. Judy was preparing to put the fat, sleek animals under the hammer.

Mr. Hill's herd thirty-seven animals were sold. Four of them were bulls. The sale totaled up \$14,350, the average price being about \$355.


