The road will be a short line along the shores of Lake Superior and St. Louis bay, in St. Louis county. The capital stock is \$1,000,000, and the incorporators are Joseph Bellward, James B. Geggie, James H. Hall, James T. Davis and John P. Morrow, all of Duluth.

A bejeweled satin clad cyprin, has paid several visits to this city from Stillwater recently and she evinces a sympathetic interest in young girls who are seeking matrimony. She is always in search of a "nice honest girl she can trust" to "do stillwater work for her." The woman was in the city again yesterday, wearing her usual dress, and was accompanied by the usual vizor. The police have been notified and will arrest her on sight.

A stormy scene took place last evening in a Cedar street mansion occupied by the family of a prominent citizen. As the grand finale of a stormy colloquy which raged for some fifteen minutes inside the house, the portals were suddenly flung wide open, and a tremendous force of Ethiopian shot in the street with a force accelerated by the pedal ornament of an equally dark-skinned damsel, who set the city of angels in a commotion that alarmed the entire neighborhood.

Last evening, at 6 o'clock, Prof. Will marched his band to the army, and paraded it before Col. Bend and other military authorities. The band was inspected by the military authorities, and was recommended to receive the band into the regiment as a regimental band. Money, Food and Clothing Needed by Settlers Evicted by Fire.

Dayton's Bluffers Kick Very Hard Against the Proposed Lincoln Park.

Carpenter Dealers Enliven the Meeting of the Court House Commission.

Yesterday Secretary Tallmadge, of the chamber of commerce, received the following communication from H. A. Campbell, who was sent to Dakota by Mayor Smith to investigate the condition of affairs among the farmers who were scourged by the recent prairie fires. The communication is self-explanatory:

HIGHMORE, Dak., April 10. * * * Mr. Yves, of St. Lawrence, met me and came down to Miller, where the committee met. Mr. Yves, Mr. Smith and G. H. Carroll, met us with a statement of Hand county losses, as follows: Fifty-five to sixty families, or about twenty-five losing everything, others losing stock and farming implements; one man burned to death and a number of others burned badly; about twenty-five families and 200 head of cattle burned, also large numbers of calves, hogs, chickens, etc., farming machinery, wagons, etc. Estimated total loss of grain and feed, \$100,000. The county has furnished seed grain, but needs feed for teams and bedding for families who lost everything. At that place there are fifteen buildings burned, and they need lumber very much; otherwise they are pretty well cared for. There are about thirty ladies at work sewing and making such things as the people need. They need tacking and sheeting, or rather yard-wide muslin; also blankets or quilts and remnants of calico, or anything that will do for children's dresses. The farmers here are poor. In Hand county they are better off. They will need some staple groceries, forks, etc. I will need money to replace them, also to buy hogs. Everything in the way of grain and feed can be bought here. If you can get deadhead rates, some other party should be sent to this point. Highmore, Hyde county, 26 families burned out, 6 deaths, 12 homes entirely gone. Farmers are needy, and sheeting, lumber about \$20 worth, some hardware, bedding as above, and money for feed, etc.; staple groceries, forks, etc. I make this by way of suggestion, and after talking to the committee. The people here are doing all they can, but none of them are millionaires. Minneapolis has reached none of these things, yet, and we are first on the ground. Chicago has been heard from, but nothing definite. They have received \$300 from Pierre and Sully. An old cloth can be used to great advantage, as they have lost all but what they have on. It is raining here to-day, and farmers are consequently hungry. I would like to see you to-morrow. The commissioners of Onida will meet me at Campbell. Respectfully yours, H. A. CAMPBELL.

KICKERS FROM THE BLUFF.

A weighty protest presented to the Park Commission Lincoln Park.

A large number of citizens assembled at the office of the board of park commissioners in the chamber of commerce building yesterday afternoon, it being their regularly appointed time of meeting. A quorum was not present, however, and the meeting was postponed until next Friday afternoon. Dayton's bluff was largely represented, many prominent residents of that district having appeared to protest against the action of the board in rescinding its resolution creating Indian Mound park and the proposed plan to condemn land for Lincoln park. The following protest to such action, signed by 260 property owners of the district, was filed with the secretary:

To the Honorable Board of Park Commissioners. The undersigned, residents and taxpayers of Dayton's bluff, feeling ourselves aggrieved by reason of your recent action in rescinding your former resolution condemning Indian Mound park, and afterwards passing a resolution taking blocks 7, 8, 9, and 10, Suburban Hills, for a park, hereby protest against the selection of this ground as a park, and respectfully request you to reconsider the action which has been taken, in order that the wishes of the people in this section of the city may be fairly considered, and that a park may not be forced upon them against their own wishes, but for which large assessments will be levied.

We are dissatisfied with the location of this proposed Lincoln Park; its situation is utterly undesirable; it would benefit only a favored few, and outside this number, who own nearly all the property in the immediate vicinity, it is universally objected to. The citizens of Dayton's bluff, of whom your petitioners consist of a representative portion, therefore we pray that your honorable body will cause the recent action condemning the proposed Lincoln Park to be rescinded, and that this park be abandoned, and not be forced upon us against our wishes.
