CAIRO, Aug. 2.—Advices from Toski bring news of increased activity at the front. Gen. Grenfell reconnoitered the derwish camp, where the dervishes fell upon the Egyptian cavalry in force and killed twenty-seven of their number, forcing the remainder of the detachment to withdraw. Later Lieut. Dauglar attacked the dervishes in front of the camp, and the dervishes were driven from the field, when they left fifteen dead behind them. Deserters are coming into the Egyptian camp in large numbers. Wad-el-Njami, the dervish leader, has been killed, it is determined to fight to the last.

WHAT IT ALL MEANS.

WINONA, Aug. 2.—The default in the payment of interest on the first mortgage bonds by the Green Bay, Winona & St. Paul railway, as noted in a dispatch from New York in the Globe this morning, is another step in the extension of the Winona & Southwestern railway. Secretary Simpson, of the latter road, said to-day in reply to a question, that the Southwestern directors had been advised that such action would be taken by the holders of the Green Bay bonds as to pass into the hands of the owners of the income bonds, who are the Delaware, Lackawanna & Western people. They have been the practical and nominal owners of the road. Now that they assume control, the proposed plan of reorganization will be carried through, and while none of the Winona directors will go into the Green Bay direction, the extension of the Southwestern railway will be the prime object of the company.
