

HOW BARRUNDIA DIED

Story of the Killing of the General on Board the Acapulco.

The Order for His Surrender Comes From Minister Mizner.

When Notified Barrundia Begins Firing on the Guatemalan Officers.

He is Killed and Dragged by the Heels Down the Gang Plank.

New York, Sept. 17.—A. P. Mulligan, who was purser of the steamer Acapulco, upon which Gen. Barrundia was butchered by soldiers of the Guatemalan government, in the harbor of San Jose de Guatemala, reached this city Monday.

He tells this story of the shooting, of which he was an eye witness. The general had fifteen trunks, two boxes and a valise. His secretary carried a satchel containing \$2,500. Capt. Pitt had the luggage searched and found six revolvers and hundreds of cartridges.
