BASE BALL IN COURT.

Preliminary Legal Scrapping Breaks Loose in Cincinnati.

Association Men File Petitions in the Superior Court.

CINCINNATI, O., March 11.—The legal battle has begun in the base ball field.

Association men, Charles A. Prince, Haynes, Dixwell, Hart, Wagner and others have filed a petition in the superior court of Cincinnati against the league warriors.

The prayer of the petition is that a receiver may be appointed to settle and determine the property rights in question, and that the defendants be enjoined from interfering upon or in any manner using the base ball grounds of the Association in this city.

The court granted a temporary restraining order to give the legal champions time to get their breath for the war of words that must now assail the ear of the judge.

The hearing upon its merits must await the convenience of the attorneys and of the court, but in the nature of things it cannot be long delayed.

The association delegates have not yet gone into session. They say that the schedule will not be ready sooner than to-morrow, however.
