A MATTER OF TASTE.

President Eliot, of Harvard university, has often shocked the people who grope in New England, but the expression of opinion that has no precedent in his position. Now he has been out to Utah, and in a public address there spoke words of violence and abuse against the Mormons in their new departure from the great mistake of their social and religious system. He accepted as honest their professions of renunciation of polygamy and purpose to settle in the West, and to take up their public affairs, and not the tools of an ecclesiasticism. He even dared to find some parallels in his historic reflection between their migration to a new and unsettled land and that of the Pilgrim fathers. Still, it shows that even in a manufacturing state, the Republican managers are not afraid of a fair discussion of the tariff policy, which is the main issue, and perhaps the only one that the outside speakers give much attention to. If it is true that McKimley promotes the interest of mechanical labor, it would be easy to confute the statements of the Democrats with the local facts. There could hardly be a better field than Rhode Island, with its varied and numerous manufactures, in which to show that more reliable and better paid employment has been had by the workmen since the consummation of the protective policy. If that has raised the wages of operatives in any industries, the beneficiaries could rise up in the face of the advocates of tariff reduction and assert the exact facts in their own cases. Instead, however, the Republicans have sought to prevent the Democrats from being heard by a species of trickery. The time was when Republicans claimed that they had an educational agency and they invited the freest discussion. That is not the suggestion of the action in Rhode Island.

MUST STAY OUT.

It has been stated, probably with some exaggeration, that there are great numbers of Chinamen on the Canadian side of the line waiting for the expiration of the exclusion act in May to flock over to the United States. If the process of naturalization as British subjects is as expeditious and simple as it seems, the process of exclusion of the Chinese are evidently insufficient to keep them out.

Ont. The treaty relations with Great Britain give free access to this country (with the exception of a subject of that realm regarding race, color or creed. The people of the United States will not consent to become the victims of the Canadian subterfuge, for it is nothing more. THE CONVENTION.

Yesterday's convention was in every way a successful and enthusiastic gathering. Mr. HAYES, of Fairbault, whom many of the delegates did not know when he was named for the place, proved a courteous, fair, alert and efficient presiding officer. On the floor were the best Democrats from all quarters of the state, and it was particularly gratifying to see among them men like Mr. DORAN, Mr. WILKINSON and Mr. BUCK, who have grown gray in the parent eastern party. There was nothing to say, and a spirit of square-dealing prevailed, no matter how much time its observance consumed. The contest over the preliminary organization and the nomination of the platform committee, district about its representation on the Chicago ticket showed that no faction controlled the deliberations, and that the traditional Democratic qualities of independence and spunk were not wanting on this occasion any more than on any other.
