The New Law Prohibits the Copying of the Old Voting Lists.

Complete List of the Registration Places Throughout the City.

Every voter who expects to vote at the coming city election in this city should register today.

The judges and clerks will be at all the polling places between the hours of 9 a. m. and 6 p. m. to attend to the registration of all voters.

Three more days will be devoted to this work of registration, as follows: Tuesday, April 13, Saturday, April 15, and Wednesday, April 16.

Under this new law all voters must register; the old poll lists cannot be copied.

While it may seem strange that an old citizen, who has resided in the same precinct for thirty or forty years, is obliged to register or lose his vote, this is the law, and every voter who has his name on any one of the old poll lists is not upon the registry lists.
