HOYT CASE QUARTER.

Judge Otis Wisely Closes the Doors on the Morbid Crowd.

Sensational Testimony in Support of the Plaintiff's Claim.

Mrs. McClellan Unblushingly Testifies to Her Own Shame.

The Story of the Alleged Visit to the Minneapolis Hotel.

REGISTER TODAY.

The action begun by James McClellan against Henry F. Hoyt to recover \$25,000 for the alienation of his wife's estate is before Judge Otis today for a jury determination. An hour and a half was required to secure a jury yesterday morning. The selection was the occasion of frequent conference between Dr. Hoyt and his attorneys, Kellogg and Kiefer. After the jury was impaneled Judge Otis stated that, in the interest of gods, morals and public policy he would exclude witnesses and spectators. He would not positively order attorneys, not interested in the case, to be excluded, but he hoped that they would not remain in the court room. It would do them no good to hear the evidence, but he had, however, no objection to their hearing the opening and closing arguments. A number of the attorneys' wives were in the room during the afternoon at the risk of displeasing the court. Before the trial began the court stated privately to the reporters that he would not exclude them, but he hoped they would be discreet in reporting the case.

Mr. Wellington outlined his case to the jury before the noon recess. He asserted that the defendant had ingratiated himself into the confidence of Mrs. McClellan through a Mrs. Shekel, whom he knew in Mexico and who was a woman of influence. That after making the acquaintance of the young and comely wife of McClellan he had won her affections from her husband and brought disgrace upon the family by defiling her upon two occasions. On one of these occasions he and a man claimed to be Fleischmann, Mrs. McClellan and Mrs. Shekel had gone to the West hotel in Minneapolis and registered as Dr. Bier and wife and H. C. Brown and wife. The latter had drunk and drunk wine in Rooms 346 and 348 of that hotel. This was Nov. 11 last. On another occasion Dr. Hoyt and Mrs. McClellan had occupied a room at 456 St. Peter street, in this city. He asserted that the defendant was aggressive in his efforts to lead the woman astray. He said this would be proven by the woman herself. She had not been entirely lost, and would tell the story of her seduction as well as possible. He said that in the South, where the blood is hot, men were killed for such wrongs, but the husband had the more deliberate and lawful course in this case and began an action for duress.

James A. Willis, bookkeeper of the West hotel, testified that 14 last the register showed that Dr. Bier and wife and H. C. Brown and wife were occupying rooms 346 and 348. They were fitted up as sleeping apartments. Dr. Bier and wife were in room 346 and Dr. Hoyt and wife in room 348. They took lunch, for which they were charged \$1 each and 50 cents each for the use of the room and the entire bill was \$14.50.

Lizzie McClellan, the wife, came into the court room yesterday afternoon after he had gone to his office and notified her that she was needed without delay. She came in in a blue dress, including tall and long light hair. She is a comely looking young woman. Her demeanor on the witness stand indicated her self-possession. Her voice was rather pleasing; her eyes are bright; her complexion clear and her features regular. She admitted the improper relations with the defendant at the times named without a blush. She and Mrs. Shekel had gone to Minneapolis to see the defendant at the time named without an appointment made the night before; they met Dr. Hoyt and Mr. Fleishmann there, and took lunch and drank champagne in a room upstairs. She said that was her first drinking. She afterwards went to the house of Mrs. Shekel, on St. Peter street, and the defendant. She first met Dr. Hoyt at the union depot in 1890. She met him several times after that at his office, where she went to ask him to see Mrs. Shekel professionally. She always denied to her husband and friends that there had been improper relations between her and Dr. Hoyt until after her return from Ohio in January last. She had not denied it to Mrs. Shekel, because she knew all about it. Her husband had been told by her servant of her drinking wine at her home in company with the defendant and Mrs. Shekel, and he had served her some thing wrong. He charged her with it the evening she went to the house on St. Peter street, but she denied the charge.

Confessed Little by Little.

She said that she is now boarding on College avenue, where she has been for six weeks. After her return from Ohio she lived at home a week, she then went to Minneapolis, where she lived for one week, and took her letters that had come to her address at St. Paul. She went to the West hotel with Mr. Wellington, where she saw her husband. She went there to be identified by the woman who keeps the house. She said this man Forbes is employed at the electric light works and she had seen him there when the electric works, where they are addressed. She said that Mrs. Shekel had been living with her for some time about the time of the escapades with the defendant. On cross-examination the defense sought to show that Mrs. Shekel had been identified by her because of an intimacy between her and McClellan. A detective is in close consultation with the defense during the trial. It is supposed that the defense is fortified with damaging testimony to answer the charges.

Henry A. Fleishmann, who is alleged to be one of the men who made up the

He said he had called at the McClellan house with Dr. Hoyt last November. He was going to tea with Dr. Hoyt, and he went into the house to keep warm while the doctor made

He told Mrs. McClellan that he had a wife and four children, and showed her their pictures, which he had in his pocket. Mrs. McClellan had put her child in his lap and told what a wonderful one he was, after he told her he was fond of children. He never saw Mrs. McClellan after that. He met Mrs. Shekel about two weeks after at the Windsor hotel and invited her and the other women to go to the Metropolitan theater. He sent a carriage for them and met them at theater and took them into a box. After the theater he sent them to the hotel in a carriage and went to his hotel alone. He asserts that he had been with Mrs. McClellan for two years, which was the occasion when he went there with a delegation of fifty aldermen from St. Louis. He denied that he had ever to J. D. Donnelly that he and Dr. Hoyt had been out with two girls, or that they had women referred to by the defendant.

Matt V. English, a waiter at the West hotel, said he was on a party of four in the rooms of the hotel last November. He had since recognized Mrs. McClellan, Dr. Hoyt and Fleishmann as three of the party. He said the man called Fleishmann, whom the defendant and were taken at Milwaukee gave the order for lunch. They stayed at the hotel
