The New Queen of the Turf Could Not Do Better Than 2:09 1-2.

Jay Eye See, at the Pacing Gait, Travels a Mile in 2:08 3-4.

Bitter Fight Between Crack Pacers, in Which Alvin Proves Victor.

CHICAGO, Aug. 20.—Nancy Hanks was set today against her record of 2:07 1/2, made last Wednesday, and fell short of the mark. She trotted a true, game mile, but could do no better than 2:09 1/2, the time by quarters being 3:25, 1:33 1/2, 1:30, 2:09 1/2.

Her failure to beat her record was a disappointment, though the feeling was general that two such miles in one week as Nancy made on Wednesday were too much to expect of an old-time leader.

She was, however, a very good horse, and as confident that the mare could lower her record, and the track was as fast as the most exacting could require, but the day was too cool, and the breeze too strong for any record smashing.

The feature of the day of the meeting, beside Nancy Hanks, was the pacing of Jay Eye See against his own trotting record of 2:10. He went around the track in 2:08 3/4, his time by quarters being 3:24, 1:32, 1:30 1/2, 2:08 3/4.

Had the same conditions of temperature and wind prevailed today as on Wednesday, the chances are that Jay Eye See would have come perilously near the mark of 2:07 1/2 set by Hal Pointer two days ago.

The old king of the trotting turf paced his mile as steadily as any work, and finished strong and fresh. J. I. Case, his owner, who drove him, is sanguine that Jay Eye See can do better than his time of today, and the little black gelding will take a good deal of the world's record with short time.
