

IN HONOR OF LUTHER.

The Reformer's Old Church Rededicated by Emperor William. He Completes the Work Begun by His Imperial Ancestor.

After the Ceremonies the Royal Party Went to Luther's House. A Banquet and a Gorgeous Pageant Follow the Later Visit.

Berlin, Oct. 31.—The Emperor William, the empress and three of their sons started this morning at a quarter past 10 o'clock for the city of Wittenberg.

At the center of interest today is the venerable Schlosskirche, the doors of which Luther defied to Rome. The restoration of the church by the munificence of the Emperor William is the era of today's celebration.

After the services the Kaiser and his wife proceeded to Luther's house. The streets on the way were thronged with an enthusiastic crowd.
