The Banks of Australia Are Slumbering Upon a Financial Volcano.

Depositors Taking Fright and Checking Out Current Balances.

The So-Called "Scotch Term" a Critical Period for Australian Banks.

Those Which Live to May 15 Will Probably Weather Future Storms.

NEW YORK, April 23.—A special London cable to the Times says: The twenty Australian banks doing business at the end of the past year, with capital and reserves amounting to about \$24,000,000, had deposited with them over \$150,000,000, of which about \$100,000,000 were time deposits, bearing interest.
