FLOUR FUTURES.

A Scheme on Foot for Trading in Them.

The members of the New York produce exchange, and particularly of the flour trade, are interested in a proposition that has been made to deal in future contracts of flour.

The members of the New York produce exchange, and particularly of the flour trade, are interested in a proposition that has been made to deal in future contracts of flour. The idea is to trade in the flour futures in much the same way as grain futures are handled. The unit of trading is to be made of carload, 150 barrels, as a basis of trading, the name of the miller to be abolished altogether.

Grade for winter and spring flour are also to be made, and the prices are to be fixed by an appointed committee. Among the advantages of the new system it is claimed is that the flour will be sold in transit, as well as upon arrival, and a dealer in Minneapolis New York dealer, is very much in favor of the scheme. At present he thinks that monopolies have destroyed the trade. Should the new plan be tried, not only would normal conditions be restored, but the surplus of flour now on hand could be disposed of. Great benefit would also result from the union action of the millers in securing accommodations from the railroads.

SILVER MEN HAPPY.

THEY SEE A SILVER TIDAL WAVE ROLLING OVER THE COUNTRY.

ARE TO STAMPEDE CONGRESS.

Gov. Waite Says We Will Have Free Coinage of Silver or Democratic Defeat—Patterson, of Colorado, Gives Out a Silver Interview—Philadelphia Abandons a Gold Shipment.

CHICAGO, Aug. 3.—The silver men were in a jolly good humor around at the Palmer house today. They were smiling, slapping each other on the back and congratulating themselves with the closing of their convention yesterday they had let loose a tidal wave of education that would roll over the country from ocean to ocean, from lakes to Gulf, and sweep single-standard Democrats and Republicans from the face of the earth. "If the present session of congress doesn't pass a free-silver bill," said Gov. Waite this morning, "then at the next election you will see the worst defeated Democratic party you ever saw, and Republicans too."

He added: "They can't bulldoze the free silver men into voting for the unconditional repeal of the Sherman law. We are uncompromisingly for free silver or nothing. Of course, I don't know what congress may do, but we have had a great, harmonious meeting yesterday they had let loose a tidal wave of education that would roll over the country from ocean to ocean, from lakes to Gulf, and sweep single-standard Democrats and Republicans from the face of the earth."

George C. Mendenhall, president of the Colorado State Silver League, was much pleased over the convention. "We called our convention to crystallize silver sentiment and disseminate knowledge among our principles among the people," he said. "That is the reason we held our meeting in a city hostile to bimetalism."

We are extremely satisfied with the earnest attention we attracted from Chicago. "What will be your tactics in endeavoring to accomplish your end at the coming session of congress?"
