

WIMAN'S STILL IN JAIL.

THE FINANCIER CLAIMS THAT HE COMMITTED NO CRIME.

DUNN'S PARTNER SAYS LITTLE.

For Fifteen Years Erastus Wiman Had Absolute Control of the Finances of the Firm—When He Took the Money It Was Undoubtedly His Intention to Return It Later.

New York, Feb. 22.—Gen. Tracy said tonight that he had been busy all day looking over the indictments and examining the papers relating to the charges made by Mr. Dun against Mr. Wiman, and that tomorrow he will endeavor to have his client released on bail.

Mr. Wiman promises to speak when his turn comes, and it is expected he will then give a statement in which he will deny the charges against him.

JOHN BENJAMIN F. TRACY, my counsel, I will make no statement until my turn comes. I am sorry to deny anything to newspaper men, but must adhere to that determination for the present.

When asked why Mr. Wiman was placed in a cell in "Murderer's Row," Wiman said he was there because he was charged with the murder of a man.

"By placing him there I did not intend to subject Mr. Wiman to any undue or for supposed indignity. The prison is very much crowded at the present time, particularly on the second and third tiers, where persons against whom similar charges are made usually confine while awaiting trial.

In many instances, two prisoners occupying the same cell. The reason I placed Mr. Wiman in No. 3 was that he would have a cell to himself, and as he came in so late yesterday evening, it was impossible to place him elsewhere.
