CHICAGO, March 10.—Wheat was dull and closed 3/4 lower than yesterday.

The uncertainty concerning the expected government report prevented much trading, and rumors that it would be bullish caused an easier feeling.

Flourations were confined to a range of 3/8c. Corn averaged 1/2c. The board reported a good demand for export, with cash corn in New York bringing 1c per bu over the May price.

It closed here with a gain for the day of 3/8c. Oats are also 3/8c higher. Provisions were irregular at a shade lower prices.
