THE BIG FULDA SCANDAL.

LAWYER BOST IS ARRAIGNED AND PLEADS NOT GUILTY.

THE TRIAL SET FOR APRIL 10.

Jury in the Case of Postmaster Carlson Returns a Verdict of Acquittal—Witnesses in the An Louisa Postoffice Case Arrive—Other Criminal Matters.

The state law making Good Friday a legal holiday in Minnesota does not apply to national affairs.

The jury in the case of John W. Carlson, the assistant postmaster at Roscoe, who was indicted on the charge of withholding a letter, brought in a verdict of acquittal.

The jury in the case of Gat-Che-Chee Monz, an Indian charged with selling liquor to other red men, also brought in a verdict of acquittal.

In the case of Barney Budd, charged with sending an indecent letter through the mails, a verdict of guilty was found, and he was fined \$25.

The grand jury returned an indictment in the Hystop-Borst case. In the afternoon Borst, who is a lawyer at Fulda, was arraigned, and pleaded not guilty, the trial being set for April 10.

The Hystop people are all Presbyterians and the Borst faction Methodists and a bitter feud has been growing between them over matters connected with the church affairs for some time past.
