

WHEAT TOUCHES A FIGURE UNKNOWN BEFORE IN THIS MONTH.

NEARLY ALL STOCKS DECLINED

A Sharp Fall Is Made on Missouri Pacific by the Bears and the Stock Drops Three Points - Selling Was Forced All Along the Line and Heavy Declines Were Made.

CHICAGO, May 15. - Wheat was very heavy today at the lowest price ever known in the month of May, and closed 1 1/2c lower. The feature of the day's trading was heavy liquidation of shorts, fine weather and increase on passage aiding in the decline. The other markets were affected by the weakness in wheat, July corn closing 1/2c lower, July soybean 1/2c lower, and provisions lower all around.
