THE BEAUTIFUL CRUISER MINNEAPOLIS CHEERED BY THOUSANDS

ALONG THE DELAWARE RIVER.

Uncle Sam Pays Nearly Three Millions for the Pet of His Navy—The Cramps Claim That "Minnie" Is More Nearly Complete Than Any Ship Ever Turned Out.

PHILADELPHIA, July 9.—The cruiser Minneapolis sailed for Boston from Cramp's shipyard at 3 o'clock this afternoon...

The contract for the building of the Minneapolis was signed on Aug. 31, 1891, the stipulated price being \$2,600,000.

The ship is guaranteed to accomplish a speed of twenty-one knots an hour, and for each quarter-knot over this developed she will pay a premium of \$50,000.

The Cramps claim that the Minneapolis was more nearly complete today than any other ship on an official trip.

Tuesday morning will see the Minneapolis in the Delaware river, where she will be met by the other ships of the fleet.

On the contrary, it was practically determined to keep at work until all was finished, and there is little indication today that it could be accomplished.
