London, Jan. 10.—The rumored dissensions in the British cabinet attracted the greatest interest in today's cabinet council, which met at noon with all the ministers present.

It was said that the first difficulty existing was that regarding Ireland. Sir William Harcourt, chancellor of the exchequer, and John Morley, chief secretary for Ireland, are understood to have been of the opinion that the Irish must be satisfied at all costs during the coming session of parliament.

With this view, it is added, Premier Rosebery and Home Secretary Asquith and other members of the cabinet do not agree. It is said that the misunderstanding as to the disposition of the surplus is much more serious than at first believed.

The main point at issue being the claim raised by some of the cabinet ministers and others that the surplus should be devoted to the use of the navy.

The press association declares that the cabinet only discussed routine work and that the reports of dissensions are entirely unfounded. The cabinet, it is said, was unanimous in respect to executing the plans for the reorganization of the navy which were formulated during the last session of parliament.
