Higher prices for the week were recorded in all of the prominent speculative railway and miscellaneous mortgages, particularly the Reading issues. The aggregate sales were \$7,729,000.

State securities were neglected, the dealings footing up only \$16,000. The tone was firm, however, and the market was well sustained.
