passing any pedestrian or bicycle going in the same direction, when the bicyclist so passing must turn to the left and the pedestrian or bicyclist passed must keep to the right.

Section 9 of Mr. Kirke's ordinance requiring the name of the owner of the bicycle to be printed upon it in a conspicuous place was referred to the committee, the members believing that it was asking too much.

Mr. Bramhall explained that it was the intention of the wheelmen to secure an ordinance which would require the wheels to be numbered to secure a license for the same, and as the wheels would then be numbered, the owner could be compelled to display the number on the handle.

A preliminary report was passed for printing Jackson street from Seventh to Ninth streets.

The committee on streets recommended that the order of the board of public works be amended to require the grading and improving of Jackson street to Patrick Thornton, be referred back to the board of public works with instructions to readvertise for bids.
