MOST FAVORABLE ARRANGEMENT. Railway Men Interested in Some Anticipated Action of the Interstate Commission.

Although it is kept well under the surface, there is said to be considerable rivalry among the transcontinental roads to secure the very distinguished honor of transporting Li Hung Chang and his royal suit across the continent.

Li will be in America for about two weeks, it is expected, and a large portion of the time will necessarily have to be spent in Washington, leaving but a day or so each for New York and Chicago, which cities are very desirous of entertaining the celebrated Celestial.

It has been the general supposition up to date that the victory would go across the continent from Washington via the Pennsylvania and the Southern Pacific, and would take a coast road up from San Francisco to Victoria and Vancouver, the latter port being the place of embarkation.

However, it is well known that this plan is very liable to be changed. Li does not like to change cars, or to travel any further than he has to, and the San Francisco route would be very tedious. It is known that the Great Northern and the Northern Pacific have both forwarded pressing invitations to the statesman to use their lines, and that every possible inducement in the line of elegant cars and special trains have been offered. But Li has declined. Now, it is said, he is considering the plan of coming up from Chicago on the Northwestern to St. Paul, and taking the Great Northern to Winnipeg, where he will confer with the Canadian Pacific, from the special train provided by the Pennsylvania system, through from Washington to his Western destination.

By coming to America, Li saves about 3,000 miles of travel, as it is 12,000 miles from Liverpool to Yokohama by water, and but 10,000 via the United States.
