ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

THE UNDERSIGNED HAVE AGREED to become and do hereby become themselves together for the purpose of becoming incorporated under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Minnesota.

ARTICLE I - The name of the corporation hereby organized shall be "The State of Minnesota, Department of Insurance."

ARTICLE II - The general nature of the business of said corporation shall be the buying and selling of insurance.

ARTICLE III - The principal office and place of business of said corporation shall be at the City of St. Paul.

ARTICLE IV - The names and residences of the persons composing said corporation are as follows:

ARTICLE V - The amount of capital stock of said corporation shall be Fifty thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE VI - The highest amount of indebtedness to which said corporation shall be at any time subject shall be the sum of Twenty thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE VII - The time of commencement of said corporation shall be the 1st day of April, A. D. 1898.

ARTICLE VIII - The government and management of said corporation shall be and is hereby vested in a board of three directors.

ARTICLE IX - The officers of said corporation shall be a president, vice president, secretary and treasurer.

ARTICLE X - The officers of president and treasurer may be elected by the stockholders.

ARTICLE XI - The directors of said corporation shall be elected by the stockholders.

ARTICLE XII - In witness whereof we hereunto set our hands and seals on this 4th day of April, 1898.
