

SUPREME COURT DECISIONS.

POWER OF STATE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION.

It Had Certain Limits Before the Passage of the Law of 1897.—Chicago Great Western Wins in Its Appeal of the Damage Suit of George Oelschegel—Syllabi of the Case.

The supreme court, in an opinion written by Judge Collins yesterday, decided that the state board of equalization, prior to the passage of an act in 1897 authorizing it to review the returns made by county auditors, had no authority to increase the assessable value of acre property in villages...

In the case of the state against J. H. Empanger, of Minnetonka village, the court holds that he is entitled to an abatement of taxes on several blocks of "town acre" property, as the assessment passed upon by the board in 1885 was invalid because it discriminated against one class of property...
