There are, however, three full sets of candidates in the Second and Sixty-third districts. The Republicans have no candidates for senator in the Twenty-sixth, Thirty-third and Fifty-fourth districts. In the Twenty-sixth district R. J. Pail is running against the regular Democrat, J. A. Oller, on what is called a citizenship ticket. NEWS OF RAILROADS

DECISION AFFECTING THE JOINT TRAFFIC ASSOCIATION CAUSES GENERAL INTEREST

FEW LOCAL MEN ARE SORRY

A Prominent Railway Attorney Says the Association Never Amounted to Much, for It Did Not Accomplish Anything—Was Intended to Bolster Up Rates, but Failed of Its Purpose.

The decision of the United States supreme court declaring the Joint Traffic association to be an illegal organization interested every person in railroad business yesterday and every shipper and merchant. It was generally accepted as meaning that freight rates in Eastern territory would soon be lowered in consequence of the decision. The G. I. O. railroads, however, and that a general demoralization of the East would be the first result of it. Rates have steadily fallen in spite of it, and that was considered by some as evidence that the decision would have no material bearing upon the situation.


MINNESOTA RAILWAY TRANSFER CO. PLANS TO COMPLETE ITS PURCHASE
