

REPORT THAT ONE OF THE CHICAGO LINES HAS BROKEN ITS AGREEMENT

INSTALLMENTS OF SALARY Such is the Term Used When the Commission Feature is Laid Aside With Much Show of Decency.

The latest feature in railroad circles is a report that one of the Chicago lines has secretly broken over the anti-commission agreement and is paying for business routed into the Northwest via its line.

The scheme of operation consists of the appointment of local agents at various points where business is in prospect, and in paying a certain percentage on the gross sales of transportation made by agents when amounts reached the \$100 figure.

While the arrangement said to be in force is not similar to the original commission scheme, it lacks none of the essential points.

The report is being received with some evidence. Railroad officials familiar with the Chicago situation are somewhat prepossessed from time to time that a break would occur and that the weak lines would either witness a falling off in earnings or make up for the business lost through the non-commission action by secret action.

The present situation gives no reason for supposing that any of the strong lines are not living up to the agreement. The action of the executives has been to their interest, and they have not been slow to capture their share of the business.
